



Training Centre Facilitator

The Centre for Sexuality is a community-based organization that provides access to non-judgmental sexual and reproductive health services and supports across the lifespan. We are seeking a **Training Centre Facilitator** to provide training to professionals. Since 2009 our Training Centre has provided educational workshops to over 25,000 professionals. We work with professionals across many sectors to build their comfort and skill to address topics related to sexuality and sexual health. This is an 18-month contract position ending July 1, 2020, which reports directly to the Training Centre Manager.

Key responsibilities will include but are not limited to the following:

- Facilitate quality adult education programming for professionals to increase their comfort and skills in addressing sexual health and sexuality with their clients. Some topics include: Creating a culture of respect for gender and sexual diversity, Building Comfort and Skills- Integrating Sexual Health into your practice, Sexuality and Boundaries, and Sexuality after trauma
- Support the development of curriculum, and ongoing evaluation of training centre programs
- Commits to staying up to date on current trends, research and best practices in the field of sexual health education and program development
- Establish and maintain positive working relationships with community partners
- Participates in ongoing program evaluation and improvement
- Participate in agency and community collaborations, initiatives and activities
- Participate in regular performance planning and reviews

Desired qualifications include:

- A combination of relevant experiences and/or related educational backgrounds
- Proven group facilitation experience
- Knowledge of adult education learning theories and principles
- Knowledge of organizational change management, organizational development, organizational capacity building, and implementation science would be an asset
- Ability to synthesize research and create curriculum that reflect best practices in sexual health
- High level of autonomy and ability to be flexible
- Ability and comfort working with diverse populations
- Knowledge of and comfort with sexuality and sexual health issues
- Pro-choice and feminist philosophies
- Commitment to anti oppressive practices
- Ability to build and maintain relationships with community partners
- Ability to work effectively in fast-paced team environment
- Excellent organization and time management skills
- Must have access to a reliable vehicle and be available to work flexible hours, including some evenings and weekends

The position is a 35 hours/week and includes periodic evening and weekend work. Out of town travel will occasionally occur with advanced notice. We offer a competitive salary, fully paid benefits, a generous vacation plan and an excellent work environment.
