



Calgary Queer Men's Community Advisory Board (CAB)

Position Title: Co-Chair

Position Description:

Centre for Sexuality is a community-based organization that provides access to non-judgmental sexual and reproductive health services and supports. The Centre for Sexuality (C4S) is developing new programming and initiatives to work with (Two Spirit, gay, bi, and queer men (2SGBQ+), including cis, trans and other gender diverse folks to support their health, wellness, and social connection. To help guide this programming, we are seeking members of the 2SGBQ+ community to join a Community Advisory Board (CAB). CAB members will regularly provide insight into the needs of 2SGBQ+ guys in the community, review proposed activities, and lead the development of initiatives. The CAB will be composed of twelve members of the 2SGBQ+ community, representing a diversity of backgrounds, experiences, and identities. This will include two Co-Chair Positions, and ten Members at Large. For this position, responsibilities include:

- Participating as a full member of the community advisory board (CAB) for Queer Men's Health at the Centre for Sexuality
- Attending quarterly CAB meetings either online or in-person
- Providing leadership of the CAB alongside other Co-Chair and Gay Men's Health Specialist (GMHS)
 - o Supporting the development of agendas and other documents for distribution to the CAB in partnership with the GMHS
 - o Leading CAB meetings, ensuring the group stays on task and completes deliverables
 - o Meeting with GMHS monthly to check in on progress of deliverables
 - o Overseeing the work of the Members at Large through check ins and follow up
- Providing insight to the CAB on community needs and preferences to help develop initiatives
- Utilizing personal networks to connect CAB with community members to facilitate activities/initiatives
- Representing the CAB at community events and initiatives as needed
- Regularly attending CAB events and supporting implementation of these events
- Participating in evaluation activities of the CAB such as focus groups, surveys, and other initiatives

Skills and Experience:

- A willingness to work collaboratively with a diverse group of individuals to achieve a common goal
- An interest in working with and for 2SGBQ+ individuals
- A knowledge of the diverse experiences of 2SGBQ+ individuals in Calgary and area
- A comfort in making tough decisions and building consensus among groups with diverse perspectives
- Strong time management and organizational skills
- Individuals must be 18 years of age or older

Compensation: The Co-Chair will be compensated \$125 per CAB meeting attended (total of \$500 per year)

Commitment: Co-Chairs will sit for a maximum of a two (2) year term, with a minimum of a one (1) year commitment
