About the Role

The C4S aims to be out in the community often to help increase awareness about the work that is done here. The Event Volunteers will help at these events. They may be booths at such events as TELUS spark after dark, Pride, helping run activities for program events, and our casino fundraisers. The possibilities for events are wide and very exciting. It involves interacting heavily with the public and explaining to interested folks what we do at the Centre and what services we provide. A volunteer will never be at an event alone, at least one C4S staff will be always there.

Skills and Knowledge Requirements

- Comfort speaking to many people throughout the day and interacting with the public.
- Ability to be on your feet for multiple hours as we are not always be chairs provided at booths.
- A quick learner who can thrive in fast pace and loud environments.
- A willingness to learn about Centre for Sexuality programs and services and share that information with the public.

Time Commitment: Casual as needed, based on event schedules. Events can take place during the day, evenings and weekends.

Training: All positions involve an agency orientation and ongoing training sessions as well as opportunities to take part in additional workshops and learning opportunities. Because this Volunteer Position involves interacting with the public, our two-day Volunteer training is required, the dates of these trainings vary though out the year.
